

Jeffrey D. Mechanick Assistant Director-Nonpublic Entities

Jeff Mechanick is assistant director—nonpublic entities for the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB). In this role, he provides strategic and technical oversight of all activities involving nongovernmental, nonpublic entities (private companies and not-for-profit organizations), oversees support of the Private Company Council, chairs the FASB's Not-for-Profit Advisory Committee, and participates in some of the FASB's broader outreach activities. He is also a member of the Technical Advisory Group of the International Financial Reporting for Nonprofit Organizations (IFR4NPO) initiative. He also has been the lead staff person for the Blue-Ribbon Panel on Standard Setting for Private Companies—a joint effort of the American Institute of CPAs (AICPA), the Financial Accounting Foundation, and the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy—and the FASB/International Accounting Standards Board Financial Crisis Advisory Group.

Prior to joining the FASB in 2006, Mr. Mechanick spent a combined twenty years working in and with the not-for-profit sector. He was the chief financial officer of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America, Inc., and before that, a senior audit manager with KPMG, LLP. Mr. Mechanick earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in biological sciences from The University of Chicago and an MBA in professional accounting from Rutgers—The State University of New Jersey. He is a member of the AICPA and the New York State Society of CPAs and has served on the AICPA's Nonprofit Organizations Expert Panel. He is also a part-time lecturer (adjunct) in Columbia University's M.S. Degree program in Nonprofit Management.
